MUNICIPALITY OF THE DISTRICT OF SHELBURNE

SUBDIVISION BY-LAW S-400

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipality of the District of Shelburne, under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, wishes to adopt the following by-law:

1. SHORT TITLE

This By-Law may be cited as By-Law S-400, the "Subdivision By-Law" and shall apply to all lands within the district.

2. CONFLICT WITH OTHER BY-LAWS

Nothing in this by-law shall be construed as authorizing non-compliance with any laws, regulations, by-laws, lawful orders or directives pursuant to any other statute, regulation or statutory or regulatory authority.

3. PROVINCIAL SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS

The Municipality of the District of Shelburne adopts the Provincial Subdivision Regulations with the following additions:

C-Private Roads

17a A private road shall have a minimum right of way width of 15.24 meters (50 feet)

17b Any proposed private road(s) in a subdivision of five (5) lot(s) or more is to be constructed and designed in accordance with Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal specifications – "Specifications of Subdivision Roads in Urban and Rural Areas" and shall have a minimum travel surface of 6.1 meters (20 feet)

Subdivision By Instrument

63 (1) iii A limit of three (3) new lots may be created by way of instrument of subdivision
